Move-in day is almost here, and we are looking forward to welcoming you to Clare Hall Residence at Brescia University College! We wish to ensure that your move-in day experience is enjoyable and runs as smoothly as possible. Move-in day is Sunday, September 4th, 2016

Your assigned move-in time into Clare Hall is: 10:30am-12:30pm

Arrival Time

Given the number of students that will be moving into residence on September 4th, we ask that you abide by your arrival time, in order help with the flow of traffic and reduce lineups for check-in and elevators. Late arrivals can be accommodated, but unfortunately earlier arrivals on move-in day cannot be accommodated.

Where to Go

Stop, Drop, and Park

Attached is a map of Brescia indicating where you will need to go to unpack your vehicle. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with this process. Please use the back Brescia Lane entrance, off of Sarnia Road. To keep traffic running smoothly we ask that the driver remain in the vehicle at all times while it is being unloaded. Once everything is out of the vehicle he/she will be directed to park in the parking lot. The driver, at this point, will then be able to join you.

Check-in

In order for you to be able to check-in to your residence room,

Orientation SOPHS will be on campus from 8:30 am- 1:000 pm to assist you with the move. However, elevator use will be limited, and although we will have lots of volunteers, you may wish to bring larger heavier items when there is less traffic.

Residence Assistants (RAs), Community Assistants (CA's) and Residence Council will be present on their floors throughout the day to welcome you and help get you settled into your new home. They are here to answer your questions, introduce you to others living in your house, and connect you with the Brescia community.
